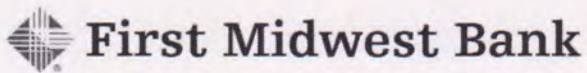

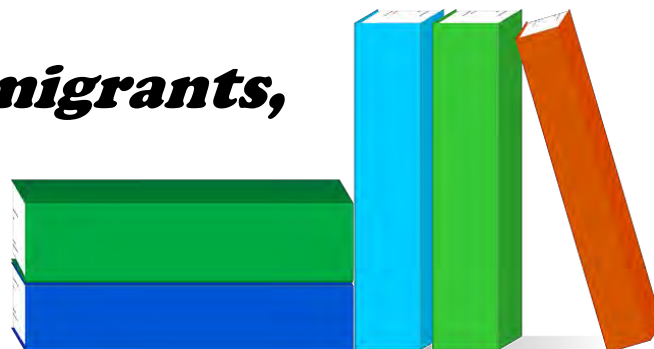

She uses the stories of several biblical immigrants (like Abraham, Hagar, and the Holy Family) alongside her own personal stories of being a first-generation Guatemalan immigrant to challenge and encourage us in how we approach immigration and those who have made the journey to this country. Gonzalez uses the Christian sacraments as the framework for telling her stories and the impact of faith on her story.

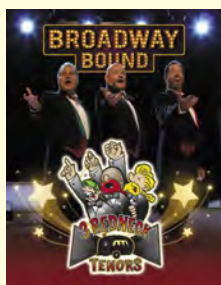

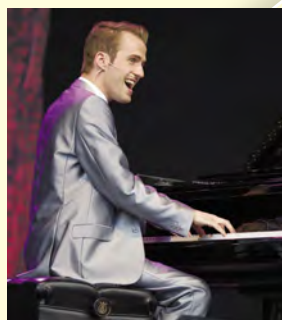

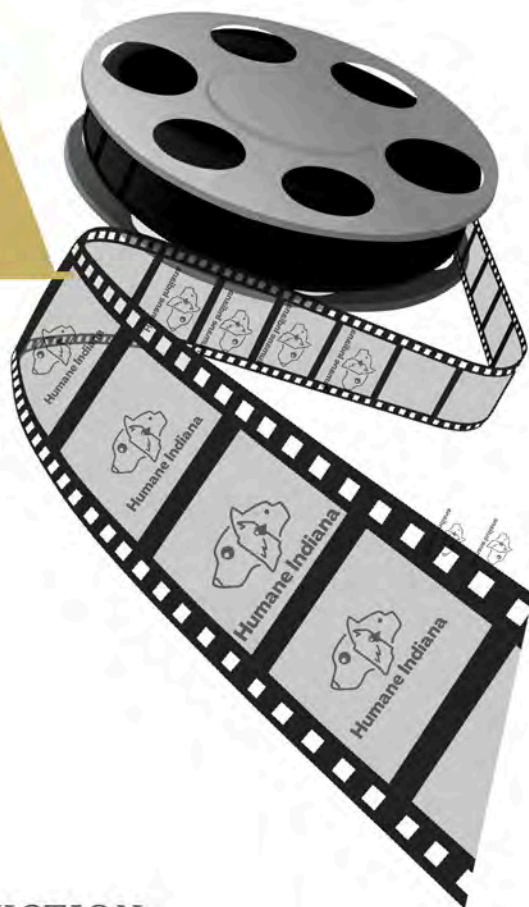
