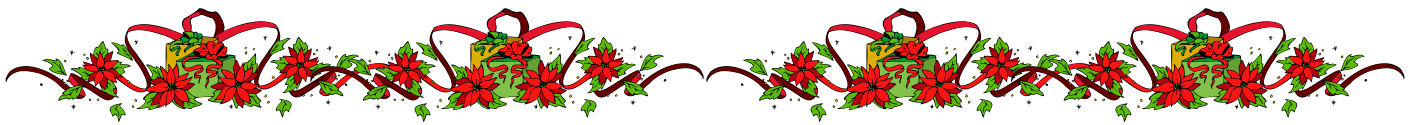

**Your support with Respite Care Services will enable us to support our community with the services below, which are all agency conducted and funded:**

**Volunteer Program:** Individuals are invited to this program in order to explore different career/employment options. Skills will be taught such as dress attire for the workplace, interviewing and job retention.

**Craft Club:** Individuals are invited to attend once a month to make handmade items. At the end of the year, they sell their items at a local craft fair.

**Meaningful Day:** The *Meaningful Day Program* allows groups of 3 individuals to share hours and go into the community to participate in a variety of meaningful activities together, such as volunteering, fitness activities, and educational learning opportunities. Groups learn and practice valuable social and problem solving skills. Your support helps provide a variety of hands on resources as well as allowing them to go on new adventures!

**Campships:** We provide campship monies for individuals with developmental disabilities to attend one week of summer camp. This gives them the opportunity to interact with their peers and gives the family one week of respite for one on one interaction with other family members .

**Monthly Activities:** We hold monthly special events and community activities to enjoy and explore the community.

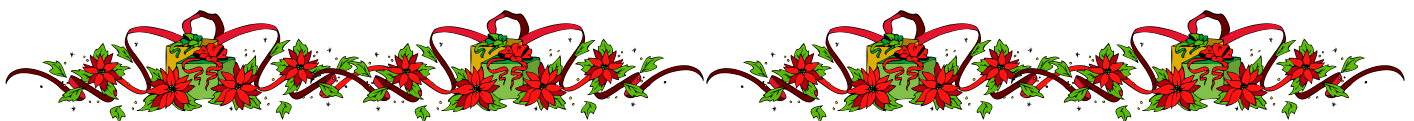
**We Can ! Literacy Program:** This gives our consumers the opportunity to increase their academic skills with hands-on creative learning in math, science, and reading. RCS, Inc believes that learning is the key in the developmental process to independence for any individual, but even more so for our consumers!

Due to COVID 19, this year, we have had to do many of our activities virtual. This includes our Meaningful Day Program, WeCan Program, and weekly bingo.

**The need for respite services grows yearly. In 2020 Respite Care Services was able to deliver over 150,000 hours of support to families.**
