With the holidays quickly approaching and the current economic conditions, there are many children that will certainly feel the impact very close to home. In the past, the Highland schools have reached out to two churches in the community to provide gifts to low income students. This year, one of the two churches was unable to participate due to the effects of COVID 19. In response, Redeemer Lutheran, Faith Church and a few of the women from the community have banded together to attempt to handle the large volume of students who qualify this year. Several other churches and organizations have also stepped up, but we still need your help.

We have been working with Counselors from all Highland grade schools and the middle school to identify our Angels in need this year. In past years, the churches supported 160+ students. This year, we are anticipating approximately 200 students will be helped with our combined efforts.

How can you help?

Individuals are encouraged to select an Angel from one of several local church Angel Trees. Each Angel ornament will have a student's first name and info to help with selecting a gift for him/her.

If you would like, you can purchase a gift, return it to the church, and identify it for the Angel Tree. Gifts will need to be returned by Sunday, December 6th.

If you would like to assist, but not do the actual shopping, you can provide a monetary donation in the name of your Angel. A member of our team will do the shopping for you and make sure that the gift is delivered to the Angel.

Businesses and Other Charities are also encouraged to participate.

Businesses can also select an Angel(s) and purchase a gift.

Donations can be made to help adopt one or more Angels. If you are willing and able, you can do the shopping. Otherwise, a member of our team will do the necessary shopping and make sure the gifts are delivered to the Angel(s).

Donations are being accepted through Sunday, December 6th.

For all monetary donations, please make checks payable to Redeemer Lutheran Church noting 'Angel Tree donation' at 9009 Kennedy Avenue. They have offered to champion our community effort.

To top all of this off, the team is also coordinating a Gift Pick-Up event to ensure that all of our Angels receive the gifts purchased specifically for them. This will certainly be a bright spot for these families under the unusual circumstances for the year.
